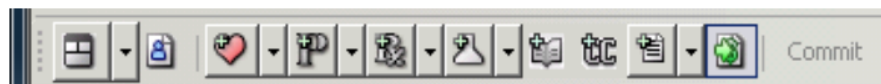
Clinical Desktop

The **Clinical Toolbar** is always docked on the **Clinical Desktop** and provides a menu of shortcut icons to quickly navigate to various clinical workspaces for commonly used actions.



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 The **Orders** icon will take a user directly to the **Labs** section of the **ACI** to add a new lab order. The system default is set to go to Lab/Procedures when the **Add New Order** icon is selected.
